Call to Order: 8:22 a.m.

Reading of Minutes: Minutes were read by Roxanne, Ranelle made a motion to accept the minutes and Erin seconded the motion. All in Favor.

YHS PTSO Rep: Heather Seaton: Thunderbird pride: The 9th graders are given tickets for positive behavior. When you're given a ticket it goes on the bingo board (Julie Beck is overseeing this). When there is a "bingo" (5 in a row) those students will get to vote on what treat (for example popcorn, soda) they would like and Mrs. Beck will provide that to them.

Parking Lot Fundraiser: The fundraiser was not very successful among the students or the teachers. There were two teachers and nine students who signed up and two students that still need to paint. Matt Carpenter still might sign up and paint his spot. Alleya Wolfe helped out a lot with the painting that day. All the paint was donated from Vista. Most of last years paint, we need more people to come and help and we ran out of time to coordinate with Crafton Hills art students.

The question is should we continue with the parking lot fundraiser for next year? Student suggestions were to combine the price of parking at the school with the fundraiser. We need to talk to REV on how they do their fundraiser. Chaparral High School has their students provide their own paint.

Right now the parking spots for A lot are \$30 with a gold card and \$40 without. B Lot is \$15 with a gold card and \$20 without. One suggestion was to charge \$35 for teachers and \$40 for students (which includes the fundraiser price). It was also suggested that we partner with ASB and make it a "before

school" activity with music and/or the band playing. We need to put together a committee and start working on this after the 1st of the year.

Valentine Fundraiser: We will start working on this in January. We need to make sure that no other groups or clubs are selling flowers. Ranelle will need help with selling valentines during the school lunch time which is 10:45 a.m. to 12:45 p.m. The price will be \$2.00 for one or a group of 3 for \$5.00. ASB to help with posters (?) We will start selling the first week of February through the 11th. We will pick up the flowers on the 12th, meet at 9:00 a.m. to tie them together and distribute them on the 13th.

Communications Coordinator: Erin will be meeting with Mark Watson after Thanksgiving to get us up and running on the school website. Erin and Kari will meet together and put the PTSO members names in the computer. We will have a board only group and a membership group. The website will include the minutes, meetings, budget, treasurer's report, the board list with names and positions only and upcoming fundraisers and events.
